/1 Councillor L Hagues – March Newsletter circulated. The Parish Council discussed the Local Government Reorganisation and how that will be determined. Food waste bin collections were discussed.

/7 To consider matters for discussion and resolution

a. to provide an update on solar/battery planning applications and provide feedback from recent consultation and correspondence.

A meeting took place in Welbourn which the Chairman attended, a recap of applications was provided, it was encouraged that people attend the meeting scheduled for this week at Lincolnshire Football Ground.

b. to discuss the Emergency Plan.

It was agreed that Wellingore Parish Council would submit the return to LCC and agreed to buddy up with Welbourn Parish Council.

c. to review the document shared by Wellingore Memorial Hall and discuss required works.

Essential works particularly to the outside of Memorial Hall was discussed at February's meeting following a recent health and safety inspection. Cllr Hathaway shared an essential works list on behalf of Wellingore Memorial Hall and requested support from the Parish Council. It was proposed that the Parish Council support with external works as the Hall is on land owned by the Parish Council. Quotes are pending for the driveway and will be shared in due course.

Decision: The Parish Council agreed to pay for the Electrical Works as they are essential works for compliance. 3 quotes must be received and a maximum value of £2950 excl VAT was agreed.

The driveway will be considered once all quotes have been received including 3 quotes for the driveway.

d. to decide on the next steps if planters are required for the garden area at the end of Barnes Lane.

Item deferred until the next meeting. The general consensus was to plant wild flowers rather than planters but a decision will be made at the next meeting.

Walnut Field – a resident has advised that a stone wall has been removed and replaced with a fence. As it is a conservation area it is deemed not in keeping with the village. Parish Clerk to email planning to raise concerns.

Poppy Appeal – Would like to purchase silhouettes of RAF or Army for around the villages. The parish council agreed to purchase two silhouettes.
